- Some of these articles are heavily biased. This may be necessary for publication in these journals, and it may be helpful to correct for this.

Time use in volunteer work

- men spend more time volunteering in things that have decision power.

- women spend more time in things focused on care.

Economic power gives a say

by China and Russia.

$$\ln(w) = \alpha_0 + \alpha_1 Ed + \alpha_2 I + \alpha_3 Ex + \alpha_4 F + u_0$$

where $Ex = \ast$ years in work force

- adjust for \ast interruptions

They try to explain α_4 by including other variables.

- i.e. perhaps \ast interruptions accounts for some of the gender wage gap.

Sustainable growth - growth w/out destroying the forces that lead to further development.

MP_k is higher where capital is scarce. Developing countries should have higher MP_k , so they should have more investment in these countries.
